The month at the Waterhole : 4 Party on the Patios plus 2 Saturday Nights on the Patio & The Howl Story Slam!

Here's the skinny on the bands rolling through the Waterhole during the month of July:

*Joslyn & The Sweet Compression* was last in Saranac Lake for Winter Carnival and returns on July 4th! This groove-hardy trip of soul music is filtered through a vivacious, and sometimes lush, modern lens, a psychedelic soundscape that exemplifies truth in music's ability to shake up the establishment.

The *New Planets* will bring their other worldly dance music to the Waterhole for the first time with this lineup on July 11th. This super group features members of other Waterhole favorite bands - Big Mean Sound Machine, Mosaic Foundation, Swamp Kids, and Dom Martyr. Expect high energy and come ready to dance!!

Saturday Nights in July just got a whole lot cooler with not one but two, Saturday Nights on the Patio! This event follows the same guiding principles that Party on the Patio does - Free, Outside, 6-10pm, and not to be missed. *The Seapods* perform on 7/13 followed by *Annie in the Water* on 7/20.

The Mallett Brothers Band, a well loved rock & roll, alternative, country rock band from the woods of Maine return on July 18th! With a style that ranges from alt-country to Americana, country, jam and roots rock, theirs is a musical melting pot that's influenced equally by the singer/songwriter tradition as by harder rock, classic country and psychedelic sounds.

*Bywater Call* makes their debut at the Waterhole on July 25th. The band previously headlined the Northern Current Community Music Festival in 2023 with an exuberant musical hybrid of Rock, Blues, R&B, and Southern Soul. Powerhouse front woman, Megan Parnell's voice is infused with the velvet growl of Joan Osborne, Janis Joplin, and Joe Cocker. Behind her, the dynamic guitar parts of Dave Barnes and a vibrant horn section creates music that is muscular and full with a smile on its face and spring in its step.

Lastly, on Tuesday July 9th, the Adirondack Center for Writing & NCPR will co-host the Howl Story Slam at the Waterhole. This live story telling completion's theme is Risky Business. Anyone can sign up to tell a story the night of the event.
