
THE ARTS ARE THRIVING IN THE ADIRONDACKS!

In 2022 BluSeed Studios is celebrating a 20th anniversary; the Adirondack Artists Guild a 25th anniversary and the 3rd Thursday ArtWalks have been going on longer than that. The Adirondack Carousel is still spinning and Pendragon Theatre and Historic Saranac Lake both have capital campaigns underway to fund building renovations: a new theatre and a new museum.
